




So, You've Decided to Go Green?

Installing Renewable Generation

Purchasing GreenPower

Carbon Offsets

Carbon offsets called Australian Carbon Credit Units (ACCUs) can be purchased to offset the emissions from the energy used, to compliment any emissions reductions made by your organisation.



Voluntary LGC Surrender

Large Scale Generation Certificates (LGCs) are part of a scheme to achieve the federal governments Renewable Energy Target. LGCs can be voluntarily surrendered for a percentage of energy as a virtual way of achieving 100% renewable energy, which is an option for large businesses who want to improve their environmental credentials.



Renewable PPA

A renewable Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) allows your organisation to directly invest in renewable generation and lock in a long-term fixed energy cost, without the upfront costs and maintenance responsibilities of installing a system. There are multiple PPA options to suit the needs of your organisation.
